Art Class

1	Oversized "Paint shirt" (an oversized, long-sleeved t-shirt that student can put on and take off by themselves) in a large Zip-lock bag (No aprons or button-down shirts). Label both the shirt and the Zip-lock bag with the student's name and grade.
1 Set	Pencil, Eraser, and Hand-Held Sharpener to bring to class each week.

Change of Clothing

Each Developmental Pre-Kindergarten student must bring a complete change of clothing: shirt, pants, socks, skirt/blouse, and underclothing. Clothing will be used in the event of an accident and does not need to be a school uniform. Labeled clothing items should be placed in a plastic bag that is labeled with the student's full name. Please exchange clothing as your child grows, keeping seasonal changes in mind.
