#### Essay questions for **Hinds Feet on High Places**:

- What are the four main lessons learned by Much-Afraid? Is there also a common underlying theme?
- Would you categorize Hinds' Feet on High Places a religious book, a spiritual book, or both? Or, do you think it's neither of these? Be sure to explain why.

#### Essay questions for **The Shack**:

- How did reading this book affect your faith? Does it change, challenge, or strengthen your image of God? Explain thoroughly.

#### Essay questions for **The Success Principles for Teens**:

- Choose one goal you plan to achieve and explain in a thorough essay how you can use this book to plan and achieve that goal.
