The Chancellor's Scholarship is awarded to a select number of students with documented accomplishments, which should include strong academic records, outstanding community service, and a history of leadership. Awards range in amounts from \$500.00 to \$1,500.00

Please adhere to the following instructions to apply for the Chancellor's Scholarship.

Deadline:

- Returning students deadline: March 30 Award date: May 30
- New student deadline: May 30 Award date: June 30

Eligibility:

- RBS students who are currently enrolled or prospective students that have completed the enrollment process and been accepted to the school.
- Student is in middle or high school
- Student has a minimum grade point average of 3.0

Instructions:

1. Information should be printed clearly.
2. This form should not be altered in any way.
3. Complete all sections of the application including essay.
4. List information chronologically beginning with the earliest date first.
5. Applicants will be judged solely on information contained on this form and the included recommendations.
6. Applications cannot be returned to applicant.
7. Applicants must include two (2) recommendations: (Recommendations must be no more than one (1) page, and signed.)
8. Place all documents in an enveloped marked SCHOLARSHIP and submit to the Admissions office.
9. Late submissions will not be accepted.
