- RBS students who are currently enrolled or prospective students that have completed the enrollment process and been accepted to the school.
- Student is in middle or high school

4. List information chronologically beginning with the earliest date first.
5. Applicants will be judged on information contained on this form, the recommendation, as well as an official audition.
6. Applications cannot be returned to applicant.
7. Applicants must include one (1) recommendation: (must be no more than one (1) page, and signed.)
8. Place all documents in an envelope marked SCHOLARSHIP and submit to the Admissions office.

### **Part 4: Audition**

Students will be contacted to schedule an individual audition date and time.

**Band:** Student is expected to perform a musical piece showcasing their abilities. Students should also be prepared to play scales (up to four flats/sharps) and sight read a small excerpt of music from standard band literature.

**Art:** Student should submit a CD containing photographs of 3-5 pieces of recent art work showcasing their abilities. Original artwork should be made available upon request.

**Choir:** Student should have a prepared piece to perform and provide CD accompaniment or indicate the performance will be a cappella.

**Drama:** Students should be prepared to perform a one-minute memorized monologue. A variety of emotions should be displayed in the monologue. Small props are acceptable.
