Please adhere to the following instructions to apply for the Chancellor's Scholarship.

Deadline:

New and Returning students deadline: March 30 Award date: May 1st

Eligibility:

- The applicant must be currently enrolled or a prospective student that has completed the enrollment process and been accepted to the school.
- The applicant must be in middle or high school.
- The applicant must have a minimum grade point average of 3.50 in all classes.

Instructions:

1. Information should be printed clearly.
2. This form should not be altered in any way.
3. Complete all sections of the application including the essay.
4. List information chronologically beginning with the earliest date first.
5. Applicants will be judged solely on information contained on this form and the included recommendations.
6. Applications cannot be returned to applicant.
7. Applicant must include two (2) recommendations from persons outside their family: (Recommendations must be no more than one (1) page and signed.)
8. Place all documents in an enveloped marked SCHOLARSHIP and submit to the main school office, Attention: Mrs. Ellerbe.
9. Late submissions will not be accepted.
